## POSTDOCTORAL PSYCHOLOGY & CLINICAL HEALTH PSYCHOLOGY RESIDENCY TRAINING PROGRAM

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NRS-Lifespan is now accepting postdoctoral-level applications for the Clinical Psychology or Clinical Health Psychology track. Prerequisites for this position include the following: (1) completion of an APA or CPA accredited graduate academic program (see further details in the Neuropsychology Brochure); (2) Applicants must have completed an internship that met APPIC standards and qualify for listing in the National Register.

The Clinical Psychology track at NRS-Lifespan encompasses both diagnostic and treatment services at an outpatient level. Postdoctoral fellows interested in the Clinical Psychology track should expect to encounter patients with a range of singular and comorbid diagnoses, including depression, anxiety, adjustment and trauma-related disorders, etc. Postdoctoral fellows will become competent in completing psychological examinations by using scientifically-validated, objective measures. Fellows will also be responsible for treating patients with a variety of mental health conditions. Please note that NRS-Lifespan does not treat patients with active eating disorder symptomology or substance use issues.

The Clinical Health Psychology track focuses on delivering diagnostic and treatment services for patients experiencing co-morbid psychological and physical conditions. The physician-driven referral system offers rich opportunities for trainees interested in interdisciplinary collaboration to interact with medical providers and provide expertise regarding how psychological phenomena intersects with physical well-being. Patient populations most commonly referred for services include but not limited to: chronic pain, cardiovascular, gastrointestinal, autoimmune, headache, and women's health issues.

Clinical Health Psychology fellows will become competent in completing psychological pain and presurgical psychological examinations (see AABN Neuropsychology Brochure for full descriptions), communicating results to patients and physicians, and determining treatment plans/recommendations based on the objective data gathered from these examinations. Fellows will also participate in the following treatment services currently offered to patients: consultation, Medical Adjustment Counseling, and biofeedback.

Postdoctoral fellows will receive weekly supervision with licensed clinical psychologists. Cross-training opportunities are also available via weekly didactics held with neuropsychology postdoctoral fellows.
